PLEASE PLAN AHEAD: The North Shore Academy of the Arts (NSAA) will be presenting **Disney's The Lion King Jr.** at the Cedarburg Performing Arts Center (CPAC). We would like to give you plenty of notice to plan on bringing your students to either the 9:30 am or 12:30 pm show on Friday January 12, 2018. The cast is made up of talented students (kindergarten through 9th grade) from many area schools. You may see some familiar faces on stage! Leading up to the show, you can incorporate some of the themes presented in **Disney's The Lion King into some of your lesson plans.** Although this is not an all-comprehensive list, some curriculum connection examples would be:

- Learning about how lions live in "Prides". Themes: COMMUNITY & TEAMWORK
- Learning about African animals such as warthogs, hornbill birds, meerkats, etc...
- Writing a story with an exposition, rising action, climax, falling action and resolution
- Learning about ecosystems and atmospheres such as the jungle, African savanna and caves
- Creating African masks, drums, face painting, rhythms, etc...
- Interviewing an adult who had to face their fears and accept responsibility like the lead character Simba
- Learning about South African cultures represented such as the Zulu, Xhosa, Sotho, etc.
- Learning about Broadway musicals, Times Square, and the Minskoff Theatre where Disney's The Lion King currently plays 8 times per week
